HOW TO ADDRESS PUBLIC OFFICIALS

PRIMARY ELECTIONS:

Federal: TUESDAY, June 26, 2018

State/Local: Thursday, September, 13, 2018

To vote you **must** be enrolled in a political party.

GENERAL ELECTION:

TUESDAY, November 6, 2018

To vote you must be a U.S. citizen, 18 years old, a resident of Nassau County for 25 days as of November 6, 2018, and **you must be registered.**

NOTE: Wherever possible, websites are included when e-mail addresses are not available. When using the Internet to communicate with a public official, it is advisable to include both your postal and e-mail addresses.

All salaries are annual salaries. (+Plus expense account)

The **Committee on Open Government** is responsible for overseeing the implementation of the NYS Freedom of Information Law and the Open Meetings Law.

Information available includes status of legislation in House and Senate and dates of committee hearings that have already taken place (not a schedule of future hearings).

Federal law makes these provisions for vacancies:
The President - Vice President becomes President.
The Vice President - The President nominates a Vice President who must be confirmed by majority vote of both houses of Congress. The legal order of succession after Vice President is: Speaker of the House of Representatives, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, members of the Cabinet in a specified order beginning with the Secretary of State.

New York State law makes these provisions for vacancies:
US Senate - The Governor appoints someone to the office until the vacancy can be filled at a general election.
US House of Representatives - Depending upon date, vacancies are filled at a special election or the next general election.

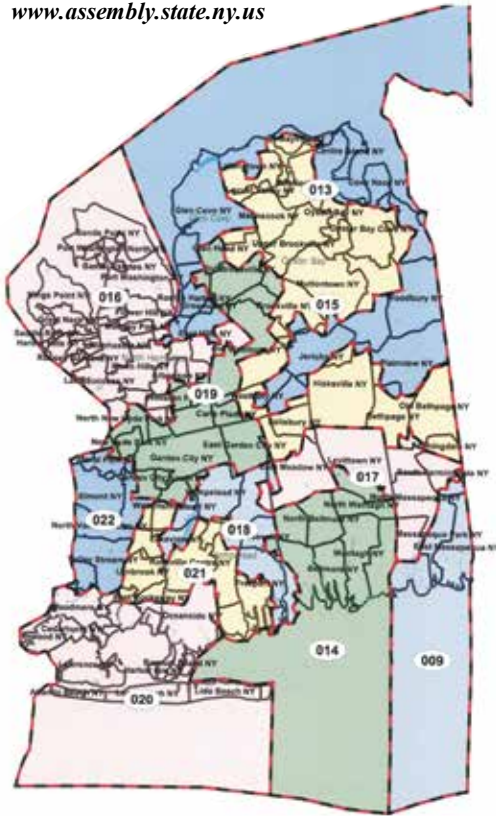

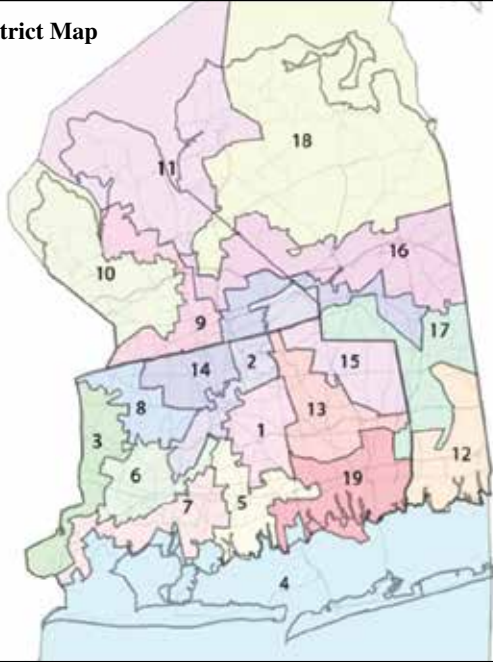
