## **Redistricting**

The Nassau County Rules Committee met and agreed to submit all maps and backup material and all testimony to the full legislature. We are waiting for a date for them to meet.

The Town of Hempstead redistricting commission agreed to submit all maps and testimony to the town board. A date has not been set for them to meet as well. Check their website. There should be at least 2 minority/majority districts.

Both Nassau County and the Town of Hempstead are expected to approve a map before the end of February since petitions for the fall elections will begin.

The NYS Redistricting Commission has proposed a new map for the NYS Assembly per court order. There will be a hearing on February 28<sup>th</sup> at Nassau Community College at 5pm open to the public. Check their website for the proposed map.
